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Pronunciation Tips:

- The letter "ll" in "me llamo" sounds like "y" in "yes" (meh YAH-moh).
- "Mucho gusto" is pronounced as "MOO-choh GOO-stoh" (ch as in "chocolate").
- "Soy de" is pronounced as "Soy deh," with a soft "deh" sound.

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
